OKLAHOMA

OKANA Resort & Indoor Waterpark; Oklahoma City

Oklahoma City's new OKANA Resort & Indoor Waterpark offers immersive amenities, such as a 100,000-square-foot indoor waterpark, 13 dining outlets, and direct access to the First Americans Museum. For meeting planners, it offers approximately 27,000 square feet of flexible meeting space designed for both visual appeal and functionality. This includes the 9,000-square-foot Grand Ballroom, the 5,000-square-foot Junior Ballroom, four breakout rooms, two executive boardrooms, and 7,500 square feet of pre-function space with custom furnishings and regionally inspired design. Outdoor options include a landscaped amphitheater for up to 1,500 guests and additional outdoor venues accommodating up to 3,000 guests.
